"Information" We All Need To Know

LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP FUND: The American Legion Legacy Scholarship is available for children whose parents lost their lives while honorably serving on active duty on or after 9/11, as well as post 9/11 veterans with a combined 50% or higher VA disability rating. To qualify and apply for The American Legion Legacy Scholarship, you must be able to answer YES to the following 3 questions.

- 1. Are you currently a high school senior and/or accepted at or attending an institution of higher education?
- 2. Is your institution of higher education a nonprofit and regionally-accredited institution? (If you are unsure, contact your institution's admission office. Regional accreditation applies to the whole school not a program.)
- 3. Does at least one of the following statements apply to you?
 - a. A legal parent of mine died while serving on active duty, U.S. military service on or after September 11, 2001. (Does not have to be a death out-of-country or in combat.)
 - b. A legal parent of mine is a Post-9/11 veteran of the U.S. military, who has been given a disability rating of 50% or higher by the Veterans Administration.



If dues are paid directly to the local post, it takes longer for National to be notified about the renewal and you may receive another renewal notice. Dues for 2017 are \$41.

In accordance to American Legion Constitution and By-Laws; ARTICLE IV - DISCIPLINE OF POST AND POST MEMBERS, Section 4: A member whose dues for the current year have not been paid by January first shall be classed as delinquent. If his dues are paid on or before February first, he shall be automatically reinstated. If he is still delinquent after February first, he shall be suspended from all privileges. If he is still under such suspension on June thirtieth of such year, his membership in The American Legion shall be forfeited. A member so suspended or whose membership has been so forfeited may be reinstated to active membership in good standing by vote of the Post and payment of current dues for the year in which the reinstatement occurs. Provided, however, that the Posts, Departments and the National Organization may waive the provisions hereof, upon payment of dues for the year in which reinstatement occurs, with reference to former members who have been prevented from the payment of dues by reason of active military service.

To renew online, just go to www.legion.org/membership/renewals and you'll be prompted to enter your Membership ID # and your last name.
